Slab: RCC slabs, the weight of roof slabs is applied as uniform pressure in kN/m^2 . For analysis purpose, it is we consider a 1 m x 1 m square section & calculate the volume of the RCC & then the same is multiplied with the density for the derivation of pressure in kN/m^2 . Weight of slab = (1 x 1 x slab thickness) x RCC density

RCC beams are cast in cement concrete reinforced with steel bars. Beams resist compression and tensile forces and add rigidity to the structure. Beams generally carry vertical gravitational forces but can also be used to carry horizontal loads (i.e., loads due to an earthquake or wind).

Design steps for RCC beam are as follows: Step 1: In the first step, calculate the intensity of the load which is expected to act on the beam. This can be found out by adding the transferrable loads from the slab to the beam, and the self-weight of the beam.

Design Steps for RCC Beam - Civil Wale

(i)Coarse aggregate: Nominal maximum size of coarse aggregate for RCC is 20 mm In no case greater than one-fourth of minimum thickness of member In heavily reinforced members 5 mm less than the minimum clear distance between the main bars or 5 mm less than the minimum cover to the reinforcement which ever is smaller

RCC meaning in civil engineering is composite material of steel and concrete (mixture of cement sand and aggregate) now called RCC acts as a structural member of column, beam, slab and footing and can resist tensile as well as compressive stresses very well.

Difference Between RCC and Prestressed Concrete ...

ACI 116 defines Roller Compacted Concrete as "concrete compacted by roller compaction"; concrete that, in its unhardened state, will support a (vibratory) roller while being compacted. RCC is usually mixed using high-capacity continuous mixing or batching equipment, delivered with trucks or conveyors, and spread with one or more bulldozers in layers (also called lifts) prior to compaction.
