The effect of intellectual property rights (IPR) policies on the pattern of trade remains contested in the academic literature. While some papers have found substantial effects (e.g. Maskus and Penubarti 1995, Ivus 2010, 2015), earlier papers found no effects (e.g. Smith 1999) or even negative effects of IPR protections on the level of trade (e.g. Ferrantino 1993).
